\$500.00 first child* \$100 for each additional child

*\$250 due on or before February 12th; remaining balance due on or before May 23rd**

**Registration fees not paid by May 23, 2025, will incur a \$100 late fee

Yearly Extended Care Registration Non-Refundable & Fees

\$50 per family registration; \$5 per hour, per child 7:00AM - 7:45AM & 3:10PM - 6:00PM

Family Parent Association Obligations

- Yearly \$400 Fundraising PROFIT per family
 - T.R.I.P. (Tuition Reduction Incentive Program): Available once obligation has been met. T.R.I.P. may only be applied to the second half of registration and/or tuition.
- Yearly purchase of four (4) event tickets of your choice per family
 - If four event tickets are not purchased, you will be invoiced \$100 at the end of the fundraising year.
- A minimum of \$50 must be spent on items of your choice during our Annual Santa fundraiser
 - If your \$50 requirement is not met, you will be invoiced the remaining balance.
- Yearly 16 Hours per family (or hours buy-out option of \$1,600.00)
 - Parent Volunteer Hour buyout must be paid by August 15, 2025.
